

- National website www.extension.org
- Community of Practice focused on topic areas
 - Content developed and posted by Experts
 - Land grant university specialists/researchers, and approved individuals
 - Currently more than 50 CoP's
- Access to content management system & support staff
- Type of content:
 - Fact sheets, webinars, video content, ask the expert services, interactive features

Why eXtension?

- The public goes to the internet for information
- CES needs to remain relevant to general public
- Improve efficiency
 - Foster cooperation between land grant institutions
 - shrinking budgets, less people
 - All land grant universities contribute funds
 - Share knowledge, avoid duplication of effort
- Learn to use online resources in workshops
 - Blogs, social networking, CMS use

eXtension Pecan Objective

Responsive, trusted (peer-reviewed) website that will educate existing and emerging pecan clientele in the areas of pecan production, dietary utilization, and economics and marketing.

SCRI Grants Require

- Clientele input & involvement
 - Industry identified priorities
 - Input in proposal development
 - Oversight panel

SCRI Grants Require

- 1:1 matching funds
 - money from clientele organizations strengthens grant
- Multi-state and trans-discipline teams
 - multi-agency is beneficial

SCRI Grant

Seeking commitments of funds from associations for three years, contingent upon a successful grant award from USDA.

SCRI Grant

Any amount of money will be helpful in leveraging federal funds, but our goal is to obtain \$20,000 to \$25,000 each year for 3 years.

Food Safety Modernization Act



FSMA

• FSMA directs the FDA to build a new, modern food safety system that includes a level playing field of standards all must follow for preventing food safety problems and a multi-faceted tool kit for gaining high rates of compliance with those standards.

FSMA

• The FDA is expected to issue proposed rules during early 2012, that would require facilities that make or handle food for people and animals to put measures in place to help prevent foodborne illness.






Summary

- FSMA focus on assuring food safety through Hazard Analysis and Risk-Based Preventive Controls.
